



## Side x Side - Snowmobile Rentals & Guided Tours

### Terms and Conditions

Effective Nov 1, 2024

#### Initial

- \_\_\_\_ Operator: Operator must sign (1) Waiver and Release of Liability (2) Safety Checklist (3) Rental Terms and Conditions (4) Provide a Valid Driver's License
- \_\_\_\_ Passenger: Any Passenger, or their parent or legal guardian, must sign the (1) waiver and release of liability. No one can participate as a passenger without a signed waiver, and I agree to ensure only participants with a signed waiver and liability release will ride on the products.
- \_\_\_\_ Fuel: Unless otherwise arranged w/ Prepaid Option, the rental begins with a full tank of fuel and shall return with a full tank. Failure to fuel will be charged at \$7.95 / gallon. Side by Sides take 91 Octane gasoline.
- \_\_\_\_ Trails: Operator agrees to only operate the on marked & approved trail system. Snowmobile trails in Minnesota have orange diamond signs on trails. Trail Maps are provided for all participants. Machines cannot be operated outside of Minnesota and should stay within 65 miles of Babbitt. While it may be legal to ride Side x Sides on select roadways in Minnesota, the rentals shall stay on the trail system.
- \_\_\_\_ Insurance: Your rental or guided tour does NOT include insurance. Any damage to the unit, or damage to other people or property as a result of operating the rental, is the renter's sole responsibility. New snowmobiles cost between \$11,000 - \$13,000, and new Side by Sides cost between \$18,000-\$32,000. We encourage you to explore/inquire about personal coverage through your existing homeowners, auto insurance companies or credit card companies for any type of coverage that may apply.
- \_\_\_\_ Repair Costs: If I damage, crash, or otherwise impact the vehicle during the rental period, I am responsible for the repair costs. Even if a 3<sup>rd</sup> party is at fault for the incident or damage, it is my responsibility to cover repairs. Repair Costs include parts, labor, and recovery fees.
- \_\_\_\_ Recovery: Lossing's charges a recovery fee for all vehicles that are crashed, damaged or otherwise need to be recovered on the trails, except for mechanical breakdown. The minimum fee is \$150 but will be invoiced at Lossing's published Shop Labor Rate for each employee required.
- \_\_\_\_ Certificates: Minnesota requires a snowmobile certificate, by law, for MN Resident born after Dec 31, 1976. Minnesota requires an ATV Safety Course for UTV riders born after July 1, 1987. It is up to the operator to obtain and present the certificate to MN DNR or law enforcement, if stopped.
- \_\_\_\_ Regulations: Lossing's has provided me access to a copy of the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources Regulations for Snowmobiling or Off Road Vehicles, which is also posted on their website for review.
