



Lossing's Power Sports Snowmobile Rental Checkout Form - 2021-2022 Snowmobile Season

- _____ I am 18 Years of Age, and I have a valid driver's license, that is not suspended
- _____ All Brakes, Lights, and Throttle are in proper working order on my rental sled when departing
- _____ Renter agrees to check all brakes, lights and throttle each time the snowmobile is started
- _____ I agree to not allow any other person to operate the snowmobile during the rental period, unless they have their own rental agreement with Lossing's Power Sports
- _____ I agree to never to get off or try to get onto a snowmobile while it is in motion
- _____ I will not allow any loose clothing to encounter the snowmobile track. Loose clothing should be avoided, and no loose clothing or body part should ever encounter a moving track.
- _____ Fuel: The rental has full tank of fuel at departure. I agree to return with full tank of 87 octane gasoline upon my return. If I don't refuel, Lossing's will refuel and charge me at \$5.29/gallon
- _____ Do not check under hood, side panels, or rear suspension while the machine is running.
- _____ Operator and Passenger must wear an approved DOT (Department of Transportation) helmet while operating
- _____ Renter/Operator agrees to only use the snowmobile on marked/approved groomed trail systems only. Snowmobile trails in Minnesota have orange diamond signs to indicate trails.
- _____ Renter/Operator agrees to refrain from the consumption of alcohol while operating the snowmobile. You may not be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol during the rental period. You can get a DUI/DWI operating snowmobiles just like other motor vehicles.
- _____ Insurance: Our machines have insurance, but the insurance is only for Lossing's Power Sports. The insurance does not cover the renter, passenger or the rental machine. Ensure you have your own insurance
- _____ Damage to the unit is the renter's sole responsibility. This means if you get into an accident, you are responsible for the costs to repair the snowmobile
- _____ Most used snowmobiles cost \$5,000-\$9,000. If I crash the snowmobile, I am responsible for the actual repair costs up to the cost of the full replacement cost of the snowmobile. The full replacement cost will be determined by Average Retail Value in NADA Snowmobile Guide
- _____ Even if another snowmobiler is responsible for my accident, I am still responsible for paying for the damage, repairs or replacement costs.
- _____ Minnesota requires snowmobile certification by law for anyone born after December 31, 1976.
- _____ Lossing's Power Sports will charge a recovery fee for all sleds that are damaged and need to be recovered in the trails. The minimum recovery fee is \$175, but will bill at the Lossing's Power Sports Labor Rate.
- _____ Lossing's staff have answered all my questions on the safe operation of the snowmobile
- _____ I will not perform any maintenance or service to this rental without prior communication with Lossing's Power Sports
